

Privacy policy and the use of cookies on the HigoSense website

If you use products and services offered by HigoSense Sp. z o.o. and you visit the website www.higosense.com, in fulfilling our obligation under Art. 13 of the GDPR, we hereby inform you as follows:

HigoSense Sp. z o.o. as the Controller

- The Controller of your personal data is HigoSense Sp. z o.o. with headquarters in Warsaw at ul. Rules of data processing

- If you use our products and services, we will process your personal data - basic identification and contact details, as well as health data. Detailed information on the scope of data processed and the rules for their processing can be found in the terms and conditions for using individual products and services.
- Using the form available on the website www.higosense.com, you can provide us with your name, surname and e-mail address for processing.
- In line with the accepted practice of most websites, the www.higosense.com website uses cookies. However, the website is not used to obtain any information about website users or to track their navigation. Cookies used by us do not store any personal data or other information collected from users.
- Information on the legal basis for the processing of personal data in our **products and services** can be found in the terms and conditions for using individual products and services.
- The basis for the processing of personal data from the contact form is our legitimate interest (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR), which is contacting you. You have the right to object to such processing at any time - to exercise this right, send a message to [data \[at\] higosense.com](mailto:data@higosense.com) Processing will take place until an objection is raised or we fulfil the purpose for which we process the data, but no longer than for a period of 3 years from its acquisition.
- After processing is completed, your personal data will be deleted.
- Your personal data may be made available by us to entities providing technical support for data processing and assisting us with marketing and public relations. Data is always shared in compliance with all the legal grounds required.
- Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries within the meaning of the GDPR.
- Your personal data will not be used in the process of automated decision making, including profiling. If this should change, you will be informed in advance.

Your rights

- You have the right to request from us access to your personal data, rectify or delete it, limit processing and object to processing, as well as the right to request data transfer. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Warsaw.

Cookies

- The website **www.higosense.com** uses cookies.
- Cookies are small pieces of information saved on your device, usually containing the website address, date of placement, expiry date, unique number and additional information consistent with the purpose of the file.
- You can disable cookies on your device in accordance with the instructions of the browser manufacturer, but this may make some or all of the website functions unavailable.
- Files generated directly by the website cannot be read by other websites.
- We use cookies for
 - the functioning of the website
 - counting the number of visits, collecting information about traffic sources, and collecting demographic data
 - conducting and optimising marketing activities
- It is not possible to identify the website user on the basis of cookies.
- We use two basic types of cookies:
 - Session - deleted at the end of the user's session
 - Persistent - stored for a longer period.
- The former are temporary files that remain on your device until you log out of the Website. "Persistent" files remain on the device for the time specified in the parameters of "cookies" or until they are manually deleted.
- You can delete cookies stored on your device at any time, in accordance with the browser manufacturer's instructions.
